Microwave Pot/Bowl Holder: Workshop: Ages 16+

Have fun making this easy and "oh, so useful" microwave potholder. Think how easy it will be to safely remove that hot bowl of soup or reheated leftovers from your microwave by just picking up the corners of this bowl-shaped potholder. Although we will make a medium-sized bowl that is perfect for soup bowls and similarly sized containers, the potholder can be easily scaled up or down. This potholder also makes a great gift.

This project uses a few 100% cotton materials so that it is safe to use inside the microwave. You get to choose the fabrics; match your kitchen décor, go wild and use lots of bright colors, or use up fabrics from your stash.

Although 2 rows of simple machine quilting get the job done, you can choose to add more quilting or practice your free-motion stitching.

1. Must know how to set-up your sewing machine and have basic sewing skills
2. The sewing machine must be in good working order.



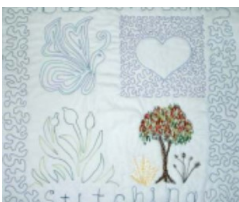
Adult Sew: Ages 16+ Two 3-hour sessions per month— See calendar for dates and times.
